



## Affordable Connectivity Program Helping Households Connect

The Affordable Connectivity Program is an FCC program that helps connect families and households struggling to afford internet service.

The Affordable Connectivity Program provides:

- Up to \$30/month discount for broadband service.

The Affordable Connectivity Program is limited to one monthly service discount per household.

### Who is Eligible?

A household is eligible for the Affordable Connectivity Program if the household income is at or below 200% of the [Federal Poverty Guidelines](#), or if a member of the household meets at least *one* of the criteria below:

- Participates in certain assistance programs, such as SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, WIC, or [Lifeline](#);
- Participates in one of several Tribal specific programs, such as Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance, Tribal Head Start, Tribal TANF, or Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations;
- Participates in the National School Lunch Program or the School Breakfast Program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision;
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year; or
- Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating broadband provider's existing low-income internet program.

### Two-Steps to Enroll

1. Go to [ACPBenefit.org](http://ACPBenefit.org) to submit an application or print out a mail-in application; and
2. Contact Horizon to select a plan and have the discount applied to your bill. We will need the following:
  - Application # and acceptance verification
  - Name as listed on application
  - Last four of Social Security # used on application
  - Date of Birth of applicant

Eligible households must **both apply for the program and contact a participating provider to select a service plan.**
